SECTION A. TERMS AND CONDITIONS: For your multi-year contract and amendments

1) How to begin the Seasonal Lawn Care Program

Please sign and return this form. The prices quoted on the front of this estimate are the current charges per treatment (plus tax) for the square foot quoted.

2) Program, Payment, and Terms

Your lawn service will start with our Five Step Standard Treatment Program (unless other programs are specified below). An invoice will be left after each treatment for your prompt remittance (payment due upon receipt of invoice).

3) Late Payment and Fees

An invoice will be left at time of service. Our technician is not allowed to accept cash. Please make payment by check, money order, VISA, MasterCard, or Discover. Payment is due upon receipt of invoice. After 30 days a late charge of \$6.00 will be added to your account and statements will be mailed the 15th of each month until balance is paid. If balance exceeds 90 days and arrangements have not been made with us, the account will be submitted to collections. You, as the customer shall bear all collection fees, attorneys' fees, court costs or any expenses involved in the collection of outstanding balances owed by you, the customer or enforcement of any portion of the contract and agreement. This contract shall be adjudicated in a court with jurisdiction located in Erie County, New York and the parties irrevocably consent to the personal jurisdiction and venue of such court. there will be a \$30.00 service charge on any check(s) not honored by applicable bank

4) 3% Pre-Payment (Volume Discount)

We will mail this information to you within three days. If you choose to pre-pay for your year's service, you will receive a 3% Volume Discount. Pre-Payment is not required to begin service.

5) Guarantee

Many variables can affect your landscape; site conditions,

weather, environmental stress, mowing, etc. and we obviously can't guarantee what we cannot control, **BUT WE CAN - AND DO - GUARANTEE OUR SERVICES**, with a minimum of a four (4) treatment program. If you are not satisfied with the results of an application, notify Seasonal Lawncare within 10 days. We will retreat the problem area free of charge. We can, at times make special recommendations to rectify and further problems from recurring. (Full service customer only). **Our goal is complete customer satisfaction.**

6) Multi-Year Contract Amendment, Annual Renewal Updates

This is a multi-year contract; we will continue to maintain your lawn in future years as defined in Exhibit A, B and C. Each spring you will receive a new Multi-Year Contract Amendment and renewal information. This will include treatment dates (including years), pricing per treatment updates, total yearly cost, product updates, new labels and special offers. By signing below you agree to receive an annual contract amendment update each spring. If you do not wish to have the benefits of a multi-year contract, cross out this section. We will then continue with our organic based program. See #7 to discontinue.

7) How to Discontinue Service

You may discontinue service at any time by providing us with a written notice 48 hours in advance of any scheduled treatments and without penalty. Previous balances will still be due.

8) Waiver of Liability

Due to the possibility of non-visible preexisting insect habitation, Seasonal Lawncare, Inc. will not be held responsible for the damage or death of any trees or shrubs treated or untreated, caused directly or indirectly from the application applied.

This Contract shall constitute the entire agreement between the parties hereto and supercedes all prior agreements and contracts, oral or written, concerning the subject matter herein and there are no oral understandings or stipulations bearing upon the effect of this Contract which have not been incorporated herein.

Specific Dates: In accordance to Article 33 Section 325.40A of the Environmental Conservation Law, the property owner or owner's agent may request the specific date or dates of the application to be provided and, if so the pesticide applicator or business must inform them of the specific dates and include that date or dates in the contract (See Schedule Below) Our Warranty and Service Pledge does not back Specific date Contracts. If you should approve a Specific Date Contract, indicate that next to your signature on the original service contract. This will have an adverse effect when timely treatment such as grub control and Japanese beetle controls are needed.

Each winter you will receive a listing of your scheduled services, which include pricing per treatment, total yearly cost with and option to pre-pay the services for the upcoming season. 3. How to Discontinue Service Amendment

You may discontinue this contract at anytime by providing us with written notice fourteen days prior to any scheduled treatments. Previous balances will still be due. All guarantees are void when service is stopped.

Label Information Sheet & Multi-Year Contract

Dear Customer,

The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) requires all lawn care companies to notify their customers with a copy of products and labels used on the customer's lawns. These labels are directed mainly to the applicator who mixes and dilutes these highly concentrated products, not the homeowner. These products are highly diluted, up to 700 times, before being used on your lawn. As always, keep out of areas until products have dried (approximately ½ an hour to 1 hour). The following is a list of potential pesticides to be applied, including brand names and generic names of active ingredients. Also included are any warnings that appear on the label and that are pertinent to the protection of humans, animals, or the environment.
